

<b>older/younger</b>	Older means being born or made before something else. Younger means being born or made after something else.
<b>same/different</b>	If something is the same, it is very similar. If something is different it is unlike or not the same.
<b>past/present</b>	The past means some time ago. The present means now.
<b>parents/grandparents</b>	Your parents are your mother and father. Your grandparents are your mother's and father's parents.

In Year One we explore key events that happen in our families - such as weddings, births, jobs and travel, as well as exploring what events are unique to my family. I know what these events are and how they have changed since my grandparents and parents were children.



We explore and compare toys from the past, those that our parents and grandparents played with to what I play with.



### Key questions .....


- How many years have I lived for?

We explore our local area, thinking about how jobs in Sunderland have changed over time.




