Dear Parents,

As part of our Science curriculum, Class 2 will be visiting RSPB Saltholme to explore habitats of plants and animals. This is an exciting opportunity for children to observe and handle creatures in their natural environment and to develop an understanding of what living things need and how they can adapt. The children will also be pond dipping!

This trip will take place on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2024. We will be leaving school around 9am and will return to school for normal home time. As this is an all-day trip, children will be provided with a packed lunch from school.

We ask that parents provide their children with:

- Water bottle
- Waterproof jacket
- A backpack to transport belongings

Children are to attend school in their normal uniform with their OPAL kit over the top, as well as wellies with a spare pair of shoes in their backpack - we will be outside for most of the day so appropriate clothing is essential.

The total cost of the trip to school is £560 for transport and venue costs (18.67 per pupil). Therefore, we would be grateful for any voluntary contributions towards the cost of this trip.
