## **Important Notice: Increase in Breakfast Club Prices**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming change regarding the pricing of our Breakfast Club, which will be effective after the Easter break (15<sup>th</sup> April 2024).

After careful consideration and thorough evaluation, we have decided to implement a modest increase in the fees for Breakfast Club from £4.00 per session to £4.50 per session. We understand that any change in pricing may raise concerns, so we want to take this opportunity to explain the reasoning behind this decision.

For the past five years, there has been no adjustment in the prices of our Breakfast Club despite the continuous rise in operational costs. However, as you may be aware, the expenses associated with running the Breakfast Club have increased significantly during this time. Factors such as staffing, food supplies, and utilities have all experienced notable inflationary pressures.

In order to ensure the continued provision and sustainability of our Breakfast Club, it has become necessary for us to make adjustments to reflect these increased costs. Our primary aim is to maintain the quality of service that our Breakfast Club offers while also safeguarding its future for the benefit of all our families.

We want to assure you that this decision was not taken lightly and has been thoroughly discussed and supported by our local governing body. We recognise the importance of the Breakfast Club in supporting our working families.

Registers for April will open this evening at 4pm and are reflective of the new price.
