## **Reading At Benedict Biscop – NURSERY PARENTS**

Dear Parents,

As part of induction evenings and home visits I know you will be aware how much we value parental support. Part of this is the communication between school and home – "What is my child doing in school and how can I best support them at home?" A question we are always asked.

At Benedict Biscop we have set up a number of systems to help you support your child and I want to take this opportunity to share these with you.

### **Early Reading & Collins eBooks**

As I am sure you are aware, reading is a vital life skill and something which we place the utmost importance on here at Benedict Biscop. **Firstly, we would like to invite you to a reading and phonics workshop which will be held on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2024, 4pm.** This workshop is designed to support you as a parent in understanding your child's reading and phonics journey.

It is the school's role to teach reading. However, **you** play a vital role, too. It is important that children have plenty of practice reading at home in order to become fluent, confident readers, also developing a love for reading.

Children will "bring home" 2 types of books:

1. a **reading practice book** (linked to their phonics scheme)
2. a **sharing book**

**Reading practice books** will be shared via the Collins Hub online platform [CLICK HERE](#). **LOG IN DETAILS CAN BE FOUND IN YOUR CHILD'S READING DIARY.** Books will be matched to your child's phonic stage and children should be able to read 95% of the words; if books are sent home that children cannot decode, it will lead to frustration for everyone. The idea is that children develop fluency and confidence- please do not worry if you think this is too easy.

**Sharing books** are books for you and your child to read and enjoy together. They will not be able to read this on their own. These books are to encourage story vocabulary, imagination and developing a reading stamina. In order to encourage your child to become a lifelong reader, it is important that they learn to read for pleasure. The sharing book is a book they have chosen for you to enjoy together.

**More information will be shared at the reading workshop - we hope you are able to join us!**

## **What is Showbie?**

Showbie is an easy-to-use app that is available on your device's APP store OR in your web browser at showbie.com. We use Showbie to set learning tasks both in school and for home learning/ homework- your child will access Showbie throughout their learning journey at Benedict Biscop and your child's profile will be split into key learning areas/folders.

In Nursery and Reception tasks will be simple and provide an opportunity for you to support your child's learning. Each week staff will also upload phonics, maths and reading learning they have completed that week as well as other home learning opportunities and tasks. Please ensure you check these folders each week.

We would like you to support your child to sign in to their new Showbie account, so they have an easy way to access their work. It's simple, secure, and it only takes a minute or two to get started.

From the log in page please select the relevant option for your child e.g. I am a primary pupil</li><li>3. Enter USERNAME &amp; PASSWORD</li></ol> <p>Once you have logged in you will see the Library screen, which contains all of the eBooks assigned to your child by their teacher. These are listed alphabetically, and you will need to use the arrows to scroll through the page numbers to find the book you wish to read.
