We have composed this leaflet to provide parents, carers and children with information on clubs that we have to offer this term, including dates, times and a description of the club.

This term, all clubs applicable to your child will be added to their Arbor account to enable you to book a place on the club/s of their choice. This will be on a first come first served basis, as clubs will be limited to a set number of spaces.

Payments will go live **TUESDAY 16TH SEPTEMBER 2025 at 4pm.**

Once payment has been made, your Arbor account will show an Invoice which will be confirmation of your child's place - we do not require a copy of this.

Payments will close on **FRIDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER**. If we receive any requests after the closing date, we may be unable to guarantee a place will be available in a club. If space is not available for your child's chosen club when you attempt to book, please inform the School Office via email on bbinfo@nllt.co.uk, and we will ensure your child is given priority next term for the club specified (if continuing).

If the school is in receipt of pupil premium funding for your child, the most expensive club of choice is free of charge and we will refund you the amount paid no later than **MONDAY 22ND SEPTEMBER 2025.**

Please remember to check your child's chosen club/s start and end dates and times as they're are different.



Cancellations may occur during the term and we will contact parents via text message to inform you of any cancellations at the earliest convenience, and will attempt to reschedule where possible. Please note - no refunds are given for cancelled sessions.

Instructions on how to book via Arbor

Step 1 – Log in to Arbor

Step 2 – Go to Clubs

- From the main menu, scroll to Activities
- Click on Clubs
- You'll see a list of all clubs available to your child

Step 3 – Choose a Club

- Select the club you'd like your child to join
- Click on the club name to see details (day, time, cost)

Step 4 – Sign Up

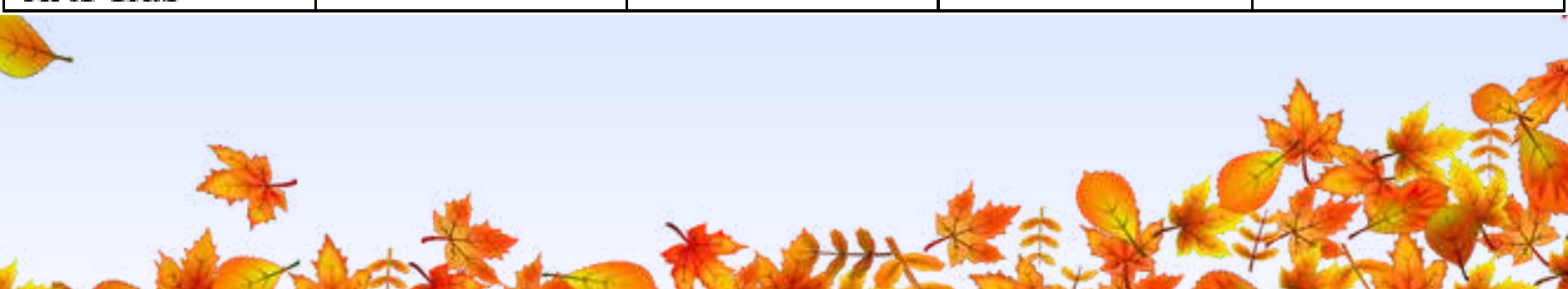
- Click Register (Name) for this club at top of screen
- Under 'choose a membership option' click 'Tap to pick' and select 'Autumn Term 2025...'
- Next
- Under 'Select Membership Periods' click 'Tap to pick' and select the option displayed then 'apply'
- Next
- Select a payment method to make payment, which will secure your child's space

Step 5 – Check Confirmation

- You can return to the Clubs section anytime to check which clubs your child is registered for, or check your child's calendar

Science Club - £30.00

Do you love Science? Come along and try some fun Science investigations. We will explore floating and sinking, investigate magnets and spend time exploring our outdoor environment - we might even make some slime. Be prepared to get messy sometimes - please bring a spare/ old oversized t-shirt!

Creative Challenges - £30.00

A fun club where we use our imagination and problem-solving skills to make cool creations! Each week we will take on different challenges like building, designing, or crafting, using different materials and tools. It's a space to get creative, try new ideas and work together with friends to create something amazing.

Arts & Crafts Club - £30.00

Come and join art and crafts club! Each week you will have the opportunity to release your inner artist and make your own masterpiece, from clay to chalk to glue and glitter! Be prepared to get creative and a little bit messy!

Karate Club - £30.00

Karate Club is an opportunity for children to learn the martial art of Karate - children will continue to have the opportunity to progress through the belt grading system, as well as having access to local competitions (at an additional cost).



Vision and Design Club - £30.00

Vision and Design Club is a creative space where imagination meets innovation. Through a mix of art, design, and problem-solving projects, members will learn how to transform concepts into reality—whether that's through sketching, digital design, model-making, or collaborative group work.

Netball Club - £30.00

Trials will be held in school on Tuesday lunch time, with an invite letter being sent before clubs go live. If your child would like to try out for the Netball Team which will be competing in the local league and tournaments, please ensure your child brings their PE kit to school on Tuesday. The Netball Team will be a full year commitment (£30 per term).

Football Club (KS1 - £31.50 & KS2 - £35.00)

Football Club offers a space for children to come together and enjoy the sport while improving their skills on the field. Open to players of all levels, the club focuses on teamwork, discipline, and strategy, creating an environment where children can learn and grow through regular practice and friendly matches.

Wellness Club - £27.00

Pupils will take part in calming and energising activities designed to promote healthy living and positive wellbeing; from yoga sessions that help us relax, to 'healthy minds' activities that build resilience and positivity. We'll also enjoy creative and calming activities such as colouring in and explore the importance of healthy eating by making nutritious snacks like fruit salads.

Performing Arts Club - £27.00

Performing Arts Club will give children the opportunity to sing, act and dance, while building their confidence as they work towards producing a Summer Show. We will begin preparing in the Autumn Term, and the Spring and Summer Terms will be invite only (charge per term) as rehearsals continue for the final performance. This Autumn Term we are especially excited to welcome the Atlas Theatre Company, who will help the children learn new skills and bring along theatre equipment to make rehearsals even more engaging.

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
