Book and Breakfast will be accessible via the hall doors. Doors will open at 8:30am until 9:15am.

Sessions are year group specific, as outlined above, **however** this is for capacity issues only and anyone is welcome to each session, e.g., if you have more than one child or you cannot attend the date identified. Please do not feel obliged to purchase a book – come along and enjoy breakfast anyway.
