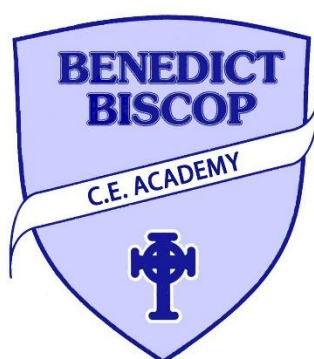


Parents Evening Questionnaire Analysis November 2025



158 responses

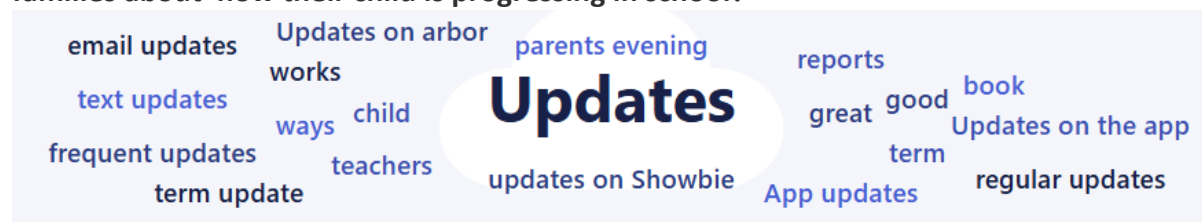
During two parents evening our Pupil Parliament Representatives and Rights Knights spoke to parents and carers and sought feedback on school systems. They received the following response feedback:

1. Does our parents evening format work for you?

Yes	Sometimes	No
95%	3%	2%

The current format of our parents evening works for the majority of parents and carers.

2. What suggestions do you have that would help improve how we communicate to families about how their child is progressing in school?



-65% did not make any further suggestions or suggested no further changes were required

Several parents suggested

-6% recommended further messages/updates on Arbor

-4% recommended further use of Showbie

-3% more written reports/end of term update

-2% suggested considering how school could make it easier to have direct contact with teachers

-2% suggested further communication through a communication book/diary

**all other suggested were 1% or less in responses*

The majority of responses were satisfied with the forms of communication that is used to help parents to understand how their child is progressing at school. The highest responses were linked to greater use of our Arbor App and our Showbie platform. School have

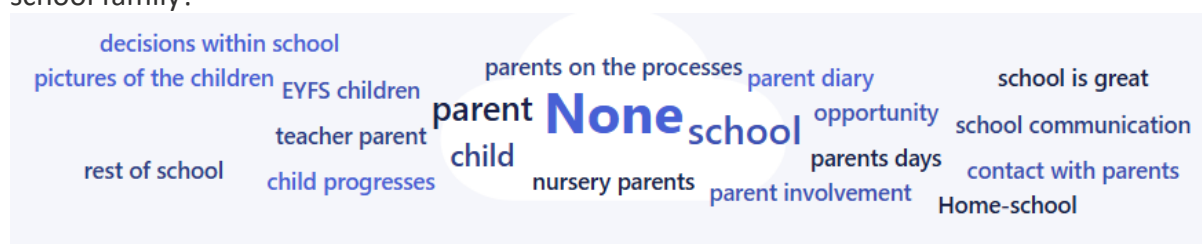
purchased these systems to enable more effective communication between home and school and we will continue to look into how we can utilise these further. Current systems are designed to support effective communication without increasing workload for staff who are predominately class based during the day.

3. Do you feel valued as a partner in your child's education and part of our school community?

93%	6%	1%

The majority of pupils answered 'no' with 'maybe' next. 16% of pupils answer yes. School recognises that bullying may happen however these figures are not consistent with school records.

4. What suggestions do you have that would help you feel more valued and a part of our school family?



89% parents did not make any further recommendations, with several positive comments made about the school, including:

'We feel we are already a member of the family'

'Great as it is'

'We feel valued'

'I think enough is done. All staff are very chatty and friendly and I have the opportunity to come into school every Friday for shared worship. We also love the classes we can participate in.'

'The current system works perfect. Regular updates, approachable and helpful staff/teachers.'
